JOB ROLE

The role is that of a Consultant and Analyst responsible for providing project management and analytical support to Nyras Partners in delivering consultancy services direct to the client. You will also be involved in business development activity.

Reporting directly to the Nyras Partner responsible for our current team of four Consultant Analysts. S/he will be allocated to one or more assignments at any given time and for each specific Project will report to the respective Lead Partner for the duration of that Project. The objective of the role is to work in a collaborative way with each Nyras project team to deliver timely and value added support to our clients.
